The course is located on the campus of Trek Bicycle world headquarters in Waterloo, Wisconsin and has varied terrain and features some challenging sections including - flyovers, off camber sections, paved start/finish, short but steep hills and wooded sections. The course will vary Friday through Sunday.

Trek's four days of festivities begin on Thursday afternoon with a pre-ride party, and amateur racing runs all weekend starting first thing Friday morning.

UCI race offerings include Men and Women Elite C2 races Friday, Men and Women Junior races on Friday, and Men and Women World Cup races on Sunday.

Feeling less competitive? Rub elbows with the pros on fun rides at our Friday and Saturday Legends races or bring the kiddos for their midday short-course showdowns on Saturday and Sunday.

Riders of all genders, ages, categories, sprockets, and speeds will find ample opportunities to race. This is a weekend for everyone.

DIRECTIONS/AIRPORTS

The race course is on the Trek Headquarters campus at <u>801 W Madison St, Waterloo, WI</u> <u>53594</u>. Waterloo is located between Madison and Milwaukee.

From Madison: take I-94 E. Take exit 250 from I-94 E (15.9 mi). Turn Left and continue on WI-73 N. Turn Right and take WI-19 E and follow signs to Trek.

From Chicago or Milwaukee: take I-94 W to WI-89 N in Lake Mills. Turn right onto WI-89 N. Take WI-89 approx. 6 miles to Town Hall Road. Turn Left onto Town Hall Road. Take Town Hall Road to Hwy O. Turn Right on Hwy O. Take Hwy. O approx. 3 miles to McKay Way. Turn Left on McKay Way. Proceed to Trek.

Dane County Regional Airport (city code: MSN) is located 15 miles from Waterloo, northeast of downtown Madison. The airport has 95 departures and arrivals daily. Milwaukee's Mitchell Field Airport (city code: MKE) is 68 miles away from Waterloo, is the largest airport in Wisconsin and has over 200 daily departures.

PARKING

Free automobile parking for spectators and racers is available on a first-come, first-served basis in designated parking lots. Please do not park in areas marked for authorized vehicles or marked as "no parking". Vehicles in those areas may be ticketed or towed.

RV/Bus/Sprinter Van/Trailer Parking and Space for Tents for Amateur Athletes and Teams Amateur athletes and teams may reserve team/tent space of various sizes in advance on the Registration site. These spaces are available by reservation only and are first come first serve. No tents may be erected on Trek property or parking lots without the permission of the race organization.

UCI Cyclo-cross World Cup Athletes and Teams Parking

In accordance with UCI regulations, UCI Cyclo-cross World Cup Athletes and Teams are provided with parking passes and may contact the race organization for reserved parking info. Premium parking and parking for larger vehicles is available at an additional cost. Parking passes will be distributed at packet pickup in the Trek lobby starting Friday, October 13th at 8am or at the UCI Cyclo-cross World Cup's Riders Registration pickup on Saturday, October 14th.





PERMITTING, RULES & REGULATIONS

Permits

USA Cycling Races under USA Cycling permit #2023-7755. All USA Cycling rules and regulations shall apply.

UCI Races held under UCI permits and regulations. The UCI scale of penalties shall apply. Please note that categories and schedules are different each day to accommodate the UCI and World Cup racing.

Eligibility

Non-UCI Riders: USA Cycling Men and Women must have a current USA Cycling license (or their country's national cycling federation) valid for the age and CX category in the race entered. Cyclocross racing age is the age a rider will be as of December 31, 2024.

UCI C2 Races: All racers must have a valid license with a UCI ID issued by a National Federation recognized by the UCI.

UCI Elite Men: Open to riders with male licenses whose 2023-2024 racing age is 19 and above AND USAC CX Category 1 or 2

UCI Elite Women: Open to riders with female licenses whose 2023-2024 racing age is 17 and above AND USAC CX Category 1 or 2 or 3

UCI Junior Men: Open to riders with male licenses whose 2023-2024 racing age is 17 or 18 AND who have a UCI ID.

UCI Junior Women: Open to riders with female licenses whose 2023-2024 racing age is 17 or 18 AND who have a UCI ID.

UCI Cyclo-cross World Cup Races: Contact your National Federation for eligibility and registration procedure.

Second race/day \$25

Registration fees above are for the first race of each day. Registration will close when field size limit is reached. No wait lists. Each start time has a combined field limit of 150 riders.

Day-of registration is available for all races that have not met the field limit except for UCI C2 races on Friday, UCI Junior races on Friday, and UCI World Cup races on Sunday. There is NO ON-SITE REGISTRATION FOR UCI RACES.





PACKET PICK-UP

Number pickup for each race (excluding the UCI Cyclo-cross World Cup races) closes 90 minutes prior to each race start. USAC license, UCI license, or photo ID is required for packet pick-up.

BIB NUMBER PLACEMENT

Pinning your number correctly is an important part of competing at events! The better you pin your bib number, the easier it is for us to produce results quickly and accurately. Ask a USA Cycling official or registration worker if you need any additional guidance on bib number placement.

Amateur riders will be issued one bib number to be worn on the right side as in the below image. UCI riders will also be issued two shoulder numbers to be worn on the front of the shoulders, visible when looking at the front of the rider.







STAGING PROTOCOL & START ORDER

All riders must report to the starting grid at least 15 minutes prior to their race start. Riders will be called in order to fill the grid, with 8 riders across in each row.

Amateur races: Callups will be determined by CrossResults.com ranking order.

Friday UCI races: Callups will be determined by UCI Cyclo-cross points as are currently reflected on the UCI website. Unranked riders will be randomly assigned starting positions behind all ranked riders, per UCI rule.

- Riders who miss call-ups will not be granted their spot in the grid
- Call-up order can be viewed on the race predictor HERE. Order may change throughout the
 weekend based on race results and new rider registrations. Call-up order will be generated
 90 minutes before the start of each race.





LAPPED RIDERS

USA Cycling Races: Every effort will be made to permit all riders to complete the full length of their race. USA Cycling rule 4H1(d) Early Bell will be used: Officials shall attempt to indicate 1 lap to go by announcement, a bell or lap counter that riders will finish in the next lap. However, all riders finish when the lap cards indicate 0.

UCI C2 Races and UCI Cyclo-cross World Cup Races: the "80% rule" applies as described in UCI article 5.1.052. Concerned riders will be listed in the results in the order in which they are pulled out of the race plus number of laps that have not been completed.

UCI Junior Races: *if used during the UCI Junior races*, amateur riders on the course at the same time must also exit the course in the 80% zone if lapped or pulled by an official. Concerned riders will be listed in the results in the order in which they are pulled out of the race plus number of laps that have not been completed.





UNAUTHORIZED REFRESHMENTS

No feeding is permitted. Riders are advised to add a water bottle on their bikes if necessary. Accepting hand-ups from spectators or mechanics – including bottles, cans or money – is not permitted and will result in disqualification. No alcohol is permitted on the course or in the technical areas.






ANTI-DOPING

All races are conducted under USA Cycling, UCI, and ITA anti-doping regulations. Trek CX Cup is part of the USA Cycling RaceClean program. All USA Cycling race categories are subject to anti-doping regulations and may be tested by ITA. ITA testing will be under the control of WADA. Riders who are selected for doping control will be notified by a chaperone.

The Anti-Doping room is located inside Trek Medical Clinic. Follow the signs from the Finish Area.







MEDIA ROOM & PRESS CONFERENCES

The Media Room is located in the Trek Building and can be accessed by the sidewalk to the lower parking area. The Media Room is available to individuals with media credentials and will be open during the competition schedule.

UCI C2 Races: No press conference will be held following Friday's UCI C2 races. The top 3 riders in Friday's men's and women's UCI C2 races will be asked to remain in the Mix Zone near the podium area after the ceremony for interviews.

UCI World Cup Races: No Press Conference will be held at the conclusion of the Sunday UCI Cyclo-cross World Cup Women's Elite or Men's Elite race. Riders will be available to media in the Mix Zone adjacent to the podium area.

Anytime outside these hours, the media room will be locked.

The media room contains high speed wifi, power strips/plugs/electrical outlets for charging equipment, desks/workspaces, and snacks/drinks.

Accredited media personnel will receive a Trek CX Cup media badge for all races, a UCI media vest for Sunday's World Cup race, and access to media room. Media access areas will be marked throughout the course and World Cup specific access areas will be determined based on UCI media vest assignments.

UCI approval required for any media drones.

PIT ACCESS

Please note that only working mechanics are allowed in the pit – no media, friends, family members or spectators are permitted.

Pressure washers located in the Pit Area are for the exclusive use of the race in progress.

Two public bike washes are available: one near the Trailhead Building and the other near the lower parking lot.

USA Cycling Races: No Pit Passes are required for access to the pit during USA Cycling events. Each rider is allowed 2 helpers. If you place a bike in the pit, please remove your bike promptly after your race is completed.

Friday UCI C2 Races: Pit Passes are required for access to the pit on Friday for UCI rider mechanics. Each rider may request (2) Pit Passes at number pick-up. Riders will be assigned pit boxes to use for this race.

Sunday UCI World Cup Races: Pit Passes are required for access to the pit on Sunday for UCI rider mechanics. Each rider may request (2) Pit Passes, available at Saturday's rider confirmation meeting.

PRIZES/AWARD PROTOCOL

AMATEURS

The top 3 riders in each amateur division listed in each line on the schedule will be awarded Riders must report to the podium after results are final to participate in the podium presentation and claim prizes.

Friday UCI C2 Junior UCI Races

The top 3 riders in each division are required to report to the podium immediately following their races for podium presentations.

Prize money will be awarded via cash at the Trek Store tent in the Expo Area.

- The 2023 UCI exchange rate is 1 Euros = xx US Dollars.
- US Citizens will need to complete <u>IRS form W-9</u> to receive prize money.
- Foreign riders will need to complete IRS form 8233 or IRS form W-8 to receive prizes.

The rider's contribution to Anti-Doping, 2%, is included in the prize money, which will be deducted before the prize money is paid to the rider.

PIT ACCESS

Please note that only working mechanics are allowed in the pit – no media, friends, family members or spectators are permitted.

Pressure washers located in the Pit Area are for the exclusive use of the race in progress. Two public bike washes are available: one near the Trailhead Building and the other near the lower parking lot.

Sunday UCI World Cup Races:

- 1. Each rider has a right to two mechanics + one paramedical assistant. No other personnel will be allowed in the pit area. Pit passes (wristbands) will be issued during rider confirmation, after the check of assistants' licenses by commissaires (see below).
- 2. Elite riders will be assigned designated pit box areas for mechanics and where bike changes will take place. Pit boxes will be assigned during the UCI Cyclo-cross World Cup Team Manager meeting, as per the UCI rules.
- 3. The pit pass wristband must be worn at all times while in the pit area.

5.1.041 "For the UCI cyclo-cross world cup and world championships, accreditations for rider's paramedical assistant and two mechanics will be distributed by commissaires exclusively, after that the license's check of each paramedical assistant and the mechanics has been completed."

- 1. That license does not need to be a specific license such as 'mechanic' or 'medical assistant' or 'international license'; it can be any kind of license, as long as that license is delivered by a National Federation affiliated to the UCI, with a valid date.
- 2. Those licenses will be checked by UCI commissaires during the riders' confirmation process, from 4.00pm to 5.00pm: a picture, a copy of the license or any screenshot proving the link between the owner and a National Federation will be accepted.
- 3. The license is presented by the team manager; the owner of the license doesn't need to be physically present during his license check.





STAGING PROTOCOL

All riders must report to the starting grid at least 15 minutes prior to the scheduled race start.

CHIP RETURN

World Cup riders must return their timing chips immediately following their races. Volunteers will be in the finish area to assist in removal and collect the chips.





PRIZES/AWARD PROTOCOL

The top 3 Women Elite and Men Elite riders must report to the podium immediately following their races for podium presentations.

The top 40 riders in each race will receive prize money.

Prize money will be awarded via cash at the Trek Store tent in the Expo Area.

- US Citizens will need to complete <u>IRS form W-9</u> to receive prize money.
- Foreign riders will need to complete <u>IRS form 8233</u> or <u>IRS form W-8</u> to receive prize money.

The rider's contribution to Anti-Doping, 2%, is included in the prize money, which will be deducted before the prize money is paid to the rider.
