Waukesha County Parks Camping Rules and Guidelines

The below rules will be strictly enforced. Thank you for your cooperation.

PARK HOURS: Sunrise to 10pm

SET UP/TAKE DOWN: Set up only after 8am Friday and must be cleaned up and out of park by 10pm Sunday.

FEE: \$36/2 nights, does not include park entry. Please note, you must register your vehicle for the daily park entrance fees for EACH day you are in the park if you do not have an annual membership. Please use this link to purchase your daily or annual park membership: www.waukeshacounty.gov/parkentry

QUIET TIME: 11pm – 6am

SITE CAPACITY: limit 1 camping unit, 5 or fewer campers. Parking in designated areas only.

TRAILERS: Trailered sites are 2 parking stalls wide, 26' maximum length (may park partially on grass in order to avoid extending into drive aisle). Pull or back in parallel to stall lines. No hook-ups for electric or water, and there is no dump station.

PERMITS: Site permits are nontransferable, and permit holder is liable for any and all cleanup and damage costs to the site.

NOISE: Please observe "quiet time" rules from 10pm to 7am. At all times, music and voices are to be confined to your reserved area.

ALCOHOL: Campers of legal drinking age may bring malt-based beverages and wine for their stay. Campers and their guests shall be considerate of others and of the environment, and will not be noisy, disruptive, or destructive in any way.

PERSONAL CONDUCT: No person shall engage in violent, threatening, abusive, indecent, profane, boisterous, unreasonably loud, or otherwise disorderly conduct under the circumstances in which the conduct tends to cause or provoke a disturbance in the campground.

GRILLS: No grills or fire pits of any kind.

MINORS: Campers under the age of 18 must be accompanied at all times by parent/guardian.

DOGS: Dogs must be leashed at all times (six-foot maximum length) except in designated dog exercise area. Owners of unattended, loud, or aggressive dogs will be asked to remove the dog from the park.

CLEAN-UP: A charge of \$52.33 plus tax per hour may be assessed for clean-up beyond the usual and customary.

CANCELLATIONS: By phone only at (262) 548-7801. Cancellations result in forfeit of all prepaid site fees.

LATE CHARGES: Any initial or additional fees not paid within 30 days of rental date will be forwarded to collections at an additional charge of 28%.

- There is a \$7 fee for entering the park. This is automatic and facilitated by the county park system.
