EVENT OVERVIEW

The course is located on the campus of Trek Bicycle world headquarters in Waterloo, Wisconsin, which has varied terrain and features some challenging sections including – flyovers, off camber sections, paved start/finish, short but steep hills and wooded sections. The course may vary slightly Friday through Sunday.

The course length is 3.2 km for Friday, 10/3 through Sunday, 10/5, with the similar course used for amateur and UCI races. Some course changes may apply. Podiums are located next to the finish line.

Trek's four days of festivities begin on Thursday afternoon with pre-ride and amateur packet pick-up, and amateur racing runs all weekend starting first thing Friday morning. Friday is not a part of the Trek USCX series, but selected categories on Saturday and Sunday are scored in the USCX standings.

UCI race offerings include Men Elite, Women Elite, Men 17-18, and Women 17-18 races on Saturday and Sunday. Saturday's UCI races are C1 and Sunday's UCI races are C2.

Feeling less competitive? Rub elbows with the pros on fun rides at our Saturday fun race or bring the kiddos for their midday short-course showdowns on Saturday and Sunday.

Riders of all genders, ages, categories, sprockets, and speeds will find ample opportunities to race. This is a weekend for *everyone*.

DIRECTIONS/AIRPORTS

The race course is on the Trek Headquarters campus at [801 W Madison St, Waterloo, WI 53594](#). Waterloo is located between Madison and Milwaukee.

From Madison: take I-94 E. Take exit 250 from I-94 E (15.9 mi). Turn Left and continue on WI73 N. Turn Right and take WI-19 E and follow signs to Trek.

From Chicago or Milwaukee: take I-94 W to WI-89 N in Lake Mills. Turn right onto WI-89 N. Take WI-89 approx. 6 miles to Town Hall Road. Turn Left onto Town Hall Road. Take Town Hall Road to Hwy O. Turn Right on Hwy O. Take Hwy. O approx. 3 miles to McKay Way. Turn Left on McKay Way. Proceed to Trek.

Dane County Regional Airport (city code: MSN) is located 15 miles from Waterloo, northeast of downtown Madison. The airport has 95 departures and arrivals daily. Milwaukee's Mitchell Field Airport (city code: MKE) is 68 miles away from Waterloo, is the largest airport in Wisconsin and has over 200 daily departures.

PERMITTING, RULES & REGULATIONS

Permits

USA Cycling Races under USA Cycling permit #2025-10756. All USA Cycling rules and regulations shall apply.

UCI Races held under UCI permits and regulations. The UCI scale of penalties shall apply.

Eligibility

Non-UCI Riders: USA Cycling Men and Women must have a current USA Cycling license (or their country's national cycling federation) valid for the age and CX category in the race entered. Cyclocross racing age is the age a rider will be as of December 31, 2025.

UCI C1/2 Races: All racers must have a valid international license with a UCI ID issued by a National Federation recognized by the UCI.

UCI Elite Men: Open to riders with male licenses whose 2025-2026 racing age is 19 and above

UCI Elite Women: Open to riders with female licenses whose 2025-2026 racing age is 17 and above

UCI Junior Men: Open to riders with male licenses whose 2025-2026 racing age is 17 or 18

UCI Junior Women: Open to riders with female licenses whose 2025-2026 racing age is 17 or 18

Registration fees above are for the first race of each day. Second race per day is discounted to \$45. Registration will close when field size limit is reached. No wait lists. Each start time has a combined field limit of 150 riders.

Day-of registration is available for all races that have not met the field limit except for UCI Junior and UCI Elite C1/C2 races on Saturday/Sunday. There is NO ON-SITE REGISTRATION FOR UCI RACES.

PACKET PICK-UP

Number pickup for each race closes 60 minutes prior to each race start. USAC license, UCI license, or photo ID is required for packet pick-up. All UCI numbers must be picked up from the UCI secretary, and UCI riders must check in with the UCI secretary on Sunday.

UCI riders should report to packet pick-up prepared with their mechanic's name and UCI or USAC license number in order to receive pit passes.

BIB NUMBER PLACEMENT

Pinning your number correctly is an important part of competing at events! The better you pin your bib number, the easier it is for us to produce results quickly and accurately. Ask a USA Cycling official or registration staff if you need any additional guidance on bib number placement.

Amateur riders will be issued one bib number to be worn on the right side as in the below image. UCI riders will also be issued two shoulder numbers to be worn on the front of the shoulders, visible when looking at the front of the rider.

Folded or cut race numbers are prohibited.



STAGING PROTOCOL & START ORDER

All riders must report to the starting grid at least 10 minutes prior to their race start.

Riders will be called in order to fill the grid, with 8 riders across in each row.

Amateur USCX categories: Rider call-ups/start grid position will be done for pre-registered riders only based on TREK USCX standings and crossresults.com points. The first row of riders will be those who are listed in the TREK USCX standings and present at the race. All subsequent rows will be done according to crossresults.com points. If riders are not present with 10 minutes to start and miss their call-up, they will lose their start grid position. Concerns about start order should be addressed with the Registrar no less than 90 minutes before the start of the respective event. Riders registering day of will fill in behind.

Amateur non-USCX categories: Rider call-ups/start grid position will be done for preregistered riders only based on crossresults.com points. If riders are not present with 10 minutes to start and miss their call-up, they will lose their start grid position. Concerns about start order should be addressed with the Registrar no less than 90 minutes before the start of the respective event. Riders registering day of will fill in behind.

UCI races: Callups will be determined by UCI Cyclo-cross points as are currently reflected on the UCI website. Unranked riders will be randomly assigned starting positions behind all ranked riders, per UCI rule.

RESULTS

Race results will be posted on-site on the flyover across from the finish line. There is a 15-minute protest period after each posting. All protests can be lodged with the Chief Judge at the finish tent. If results issues are identified after the protest period, race staff will make any appropriate corrections, but prizes are considered forfeited if they have already been awarded.

LAPPED RIDERS

USA Cycling Races: Every effort will be made to permit all riders to complete the full length of their race. USA Cycling rule 4H1(d) Early Bell will be used: Officials shall attempt to indicate 1 lap to go by announcement, a bell or lap counter that riders will finish in the next lap. However, all riders finish when the lap cards indicate 0.

UCI Men and Women Elite Races: the “80% rule” applies as described in UCI article 5.1.052. Concerned riders will be listed in the results in the order in which they are pulled out of the race plus number of laps that have not been completed.

UCI Junior Races: The USA Cycling rule 4H1(d) Early Bell will be used: Officials shall attempt to indicate 1 lap to go by announcement, a bell or lap counter that riders will finish in the next lap. However, all riders finish when the lap cards indicate 0.

FEEDING/UNAUTHORIZED REFRESHMENTS

Feeding is not allowed during cyclo-cross races unless specifically authorized by the Chief Commissaire, per USAC rule 4I. Nevertheless, a rider may keep and use food or drinks which they carry on their bikes. If feeding is authorized by the Chief Commissaire, the following items shall be taken into consideration:

- A recommended temperature of at least 68°F or 20°C
- The location for the feed zone will be determined by the Chief Commissaire in conjunction with the Race Organizer, and it shall not be located in the pit.
- There should be no feeding in the first two and final two laps of the race.

Accepting hand-ups from spectators or mechanics – including bottles, cans or money – is not permitted and is subject to relegation, disqualification, and/or fines. No alcohol is permitted on the course or in the technical areas.

ANTI-DOPING

All races are conducted under UCI / ITA / USADA anti-doping regulations. Riders who are selected for doping control will be notified by a chaperone. The Anti-Doping room is located inside Trek Medical Clinic. Follow the signs from the Finish Area.

LITTERING

USAC Races: Per USAC rule 4J, all riders must respect nature and the environment throughout the course and not to pollute the site. The littering zone will be the pit area along its entire length. Waste must be deposited on the side of the course. It is strictly forbidden to throw waste directly onto the course or outside the designated area, and is subject to a fine and/or disqualification.

UCI Races: Per UCI rule 5.1.063, the riders undertake to respect nature and the environment throughout the course and not to pollute the site. The littering zone will be the pit area along its entire length. Waste must be deposited on the side of the course. It is strictly forbidden to throw waste directly onto the course or outside the designated area.

PIT ACCESS

Please note that only working mechanics are allowed in the pit – no media, friends, family members or spectators are permitted.

Pressure washers located in the Pit Area are for the exclusive use of the race in progress.

Pit conduct is under the control of the USAC and UCI commissaires.

- All equipment within the pit is subject to inspection
- Pit lanes must remain clear during racing
- Riders taking the pit lane must receive assistance

USA Cycling Races: No Pit Passes are required for access to the pit during USA Cycling events. Each rider is allowed 2 helpers. If you place a bike in the pit, please remove your bike promptly after your race is completed. For amateurs racing on the course at the same time as the UCI Juniors, a certain number of pit boxes will be reserved for UCI Junior use.

UCI Junior Races: Pit passes are not required for access to the pit for UCI Junior mechanics. A certain number of pit boxes will be reserved for each junior UCI race, but specific box assignments for each rider will not be made.

UCI Elite Races: Pit Passes are required for access to the pit for Elite UCI rider mechanics. Each rider may request (2) Pit Passes at number pick-up. Pit boxes will be assigned each day by drawing lots by the UCI Commissaire. Pit box allocation lists will be available during rider confirmation for each day.

PRIZES/AWARD PROTOCOL

AMATEURS

The top 3 riders in each amateur division listed in each line on the schedule will be awarded prizes. The top 5 riders must report to the podium after results are final to participate in the podium presentation and claim prizes. The podiums are located next to the finish line.

UCI RACES

The top 3 riders in each division are required to report to the podium immediately following their races for podium presentations. The podiums are located next to the finish line.

Prize money will be awarded via cash at the podium tent, available on Saturday, 10/4 from 2pm-6pm and Sunday, 10/5 from 2pm-6pm.

- The 2025 UCI exchange rate is 1 Euros = 1.0386 US Dollars.
- US Citizens will need to complete [IRS form W-9](#) to receive prize money.
- Foreign riders will need to complete [IRS form W-8](#) to receive prizes.

The rider's contribution to Anti-Doping, 2%, is included in the prize money, which will be deducted before the prize money is paid to the rider.
